seeing examples of Mitchell ROCKS all around our campus!




School Lunch

City of Golden Update

Thanks to the feedback and support from our community at large including Mitchell families and the school, the City of Golden was awarded \$1.2 million from CDOT's Transportation Alternatives Program to fund the North Ford Complete Street Project. The project includes improvements to Ford Street, Tucker Gulch Trail, and Cressman Gulch Trail. So exciting to be a part of increasing accessibility, and safety as

our community enjoys these outdoor spaces.

News from the Health Room

Please bring the appropriate paperwork along with any medication(s) your student will need at school this year. We do not have any medication in the health room except what you provide. This includes Ibuprofen/Advil, Tylenol, cough drops, etc. All over-the-counter medications must be in an original container. All prescription medications must have a pharmacy label, even if self-carrying (inhalers or EpiPens). We cannot accept any EXPIRED medications.



<u>Medication Agreement</u>-This form is necessary for any medications (except asthma medications and allergy/anaphylaxis medications- those are on the following state forms) your student will keep at school. Requires a care provider and parent/guardian signature.

<u>Allergy State Form</u>-This form is necessary for any food allergies. If your student requires emergency medications and/or an antihistamine, such as Zyrtec or Benadryl, this one form is all that is needed. Even if your student will self-carry their medication, please provide this form signed by the care provider and a parent/guardian.

<u>Asthma State Form</u>-This form is necessary for any asthma rescue inhalers, even self-carry. Requires a care provider and parent/guardian signature.

Arrival & Dismissal

Here are some helpful reminders to make arrival and dismissal run smoothly for everyone.

DOs	DON'Ts
 Pull all the way forward in the 'yellow curb zone" Use the crosswalk and cross at corners with sidewalks. Students should exit cars on the right next to the sidewalk. Families and students walking or riding bikes use the 'horseshoe' sidewalk all the way around the bus zone. Students and families should walk scooters and bikes while on campus. Keep head and eyes up when entering drop off zones to watch for safety. 	 Get out of your car in the Hug & Zone, instead find a spot to park in a space. Cross the busy parking lot or the drive Students shouldn't exit cars on the left as there are often two lanes of traffic. Cross in front of the bus zone and traffic in the middle of the parking lot. Park on the drive next to Temp 3 in the back, students and families need to access bikes and the sidewalk at the end of the day.
