Students in grades K-3 took DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) and students in grades 1-5 took MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) earlier this year. 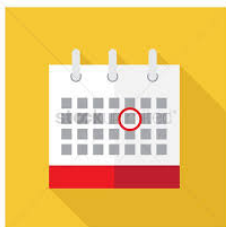
