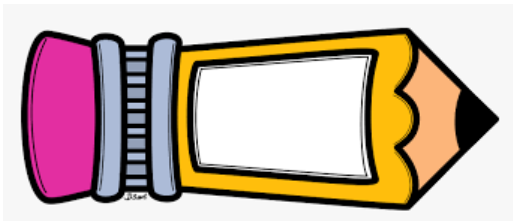



show off Golden!

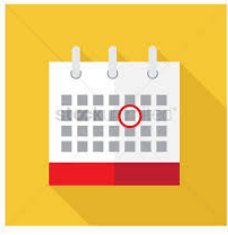
